Veto Message

For Line-Item Vetoes of the 1997 Budget Passed (As Amended)
by the Oswego Common Council, December 23, 1996

On December 26, 1996, I vetoed several amendments to the Proposed Budget for 1997, passed (as amended) by the Oswego Common Council at its regularly scheduled meeting held on December 23, 1996. Reasons for vetoes are discussed below:

1. Resolution #427b. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$2,500 from the Mayor's Budget Line A1210.450 - Fees for Service, Publicity/Videotaping, Downtown 2000 Development. This budget line is set up to support publicity related to economic growth and development in Oswego, particularly in the downtown area, and to support activities of the Downtown 2000 planning group. During the campaign season of 1995, this administration, despite much evidence to the contrary, was accused of not supporting downtown economic development. Now, a year later, attempts are being made by some members of the Oswego Common Council to deny 1997 funds for support and promotion of further economic development and planning in downtown Oswego. This veto is to help some members of the Common Council avoid an obvious inconsistency in their public actions, and to assist this City to expand its economy.

2. Resolution #427c. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$20,000 from the Assessment Budget Line A1355.450 - Fees for Service, Research: NYS Electric Services Industry. During 1997, important decisions are to be made throughout New York State regarding the pending deregulation of electrical power generation in New York State. Deregulation in New York is a "work in progress," with the potential to greatly impact upon our economy. We can be proactive, or we can be reactive, i.e., we can be participants in the process and learn how to advantage ourselves, or we can wait for the outcome of deregulation and try to "pick up the pieces." In my view, it is irresponsible for elected officials to do the latter. As I stated on page five of the Budget Message, "...we must protect our assets and our interests when changes associated with deregulation are happening rapidly." This veto restores the research funds needed to keep us abreast (hopefully ahead) of this very volatile situation.

3. Resolution #427j. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$600 from the Safety Inspection Budget Line A3620.460 - Miscellaneous Expenses, car allowance for Neal Smith. This \$50 per month allowance is to pay Neal Smith for the use of his personal car in the performance of his professional duties in the City of Oswego. Not only is this a term and condition of Mr. Smith's employment with the City of Oswego, but members of the Oswego Common Council also receive this same benefit. This veto will prevent an obvious discrimination by some members of the legislative branch of Oswego city government against a member of the executive branch.

4. Resolution #4271. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$1,000 from the Tourism Budget Line A6475.420 - Utilities, 800 number. The City of Oswego has an 800 line connected to an answering machine. That number is advertized in both our advertizing copy and on our Home Page. Not only does the 800 number provide for 24-hour coverage of requests, but it also allows the City to monitor the scope and effectiveness of its advertizing. This veto restores this important part of the Tourism budget. it also is important to note that the Tourism budget is largely supported by bed tax dollars, not by city tax payers.

5. Resolution #427n. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$4,000 from the Tourism Budget Line A6475.440 - Contracted Services, Winterfest/Power Play Tournament. In early 1996, a new tourism event was inaugurated in Oswego with great success. The first International Power Play Hockey Tournament was held with teams from the U.S., Canada, and Russia in attendance. The second tourney will be held in early 1997, with even greater interest being expressed. At present, we believe that two teams will be coming again from Russia, and plans are being made for a team from Oswego to make a return visit to play in Russia. Based upon 1996 figures, a budget of \$8,000 is adequate to provide for some transportation costs associated with the tournament. This veto restores the amount needed to support this important new event for youth in Oswego.

6. Resolution #427o. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$25,000 from the Tourism Budget Line A6475.440 - Contracted Services, Harborfest (Sponsorship of Children's Stage). For some of us in Oswego, the Children's Stage is the most important of the Harborfest events. Providing the Children's Stage costs \$25,000, an amount difficult for Harbor Festivals Inc. to fund from private sector sources. I know of no better way for the City of Oswego to show its continuing support of Harborfest (while knowing exactly where its support is going) than to fund the Children's Stage. This veto is for the children and the families of Oswego.

7. Resolution #427s. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$27,000 from the Other Economic Opportunity & Development Budget Line A6989.2 - Equipment. This new budget category is for operating the High Dam Hydro Station, and this cut of \$27,000 borders on the absurd. Three components make up this modest amount, viz., \$10,000 for a spare parts inventory, \$2,000 for miscellaneous tools to be available on site, and \$15,000 to purchase a new Autocad 13 computer station to be located in the City Engineer's office. An inventory of spare parts on site makes sense so that a needed repair can be made quickly. The total cost for a basic spare parts inventory is \$10,000. That amount of money could be lost every day that the High Dam Hydro Station might be down waiting for a replacement part to arrive. A miscellaneous tool inventory of \$2,000 is a minor investment. An Autocad 13 computer station is important for the City to monitor the continuous operation of the High Dam Hydro Station. The City of Oswego loses money every time the Hydro Station is operating at less than maximal output. The only way we can continuously monitor the Hydro Station is to have our own isolated computer station integrally connected to the Hydro Station. Further, and very importantly, the Oswego Common Council contracted with CDM Engineers to do all of the engineering design work for the ESSSP Phases III, IV, and V. All of their work will be provided to the City in Autocad 13 computer format which can only can function on such a piece of equipment to be purchased as part of this budget line. In other words, to save \$15,000 through this budget cut, the Common Council will make useless a half million dollars worth of engineering design records for a \$7.5 million dollar capital project to be completed during the next three years. It also is important to note that this entire budget line is paid for through the sale of electricity made at our High Dam Hydro Station; none of the money comes from any tax payers. This veto is for responsibility.

8. Resolution #427t. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$10,000 from the Other Economic Opportunity & Development Budget Line A6989.460 - Miscellaneous Expenses. This money is for meeting(s) and training. It is needed to understand and most effectively operate the High Dam Hydro Station. This veto helps the City of Oswego to maximize the revenue potential of our most significant investment, our electricity machine.

9. Resolution #427v. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$15,000 from the Youth Bureau Budget Line A7310.450 - Fees for Services. This budget cut is in the amount of support for the new City of Oswego Youth Center. The best way to describe how such a cut will impact upon the operation of the Youth Center during 1997, is to share a memo my office received from Ms. Kathy Fenlon, Youth Bureau Director (Attachment #1). This veto also is for the youth of Oswego.

10. Resolution #427x. Amended the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$35,000 from the Undistributed Budget Line A9090.8 - Total Quality Management (TQM). This budget line completes an effort started three years ago to introduce the City of Oswego work force to the concept of "quality" and continuous improvement. The goal has been for the supervisors to acquire the knowledge which would allow them to implement management for quality, and then to train the entire work force so that quality becomes the operating principle in our municipal work force. "Quality" saves money, a point recognized by several local companies (e.g., Alcan, Nestles, Niagara Mohawk) who have implemented TQM programs. At a time when municipal governments are chastened to be more businesslike, it is noteworthy that three members of the

Oswego Common Council, who also happen to be employees of local companies with TQM programs, would vote to sabotage our efforts and to deny our own workforce, and consequently our customers (the residents of Oswego) of the benefits of TQM training. This veto is for the City residents who are entitled to "quality" performance, and for the Oswego workforce who will be trained and empowered to deliver that quality.

11. Resolution #427z(3). Purported to amend the Proposed Operating Budget to delete \$180,000 from the Police Department Budget Line A3120.101 - Personal Services, to reflect A3120.5 - Schedule 5 as it pertains to Police Dispatchers. This proposed cut of \$180,000 was earmarked in the Resolution #427z(3), as presented, to be taken from Budget Line A3120.101. That budget line, however, does not exist. The Police Personal Services Budget Line is A3120.1, not A3120.101, and A3120.5 is just a listing of employees by department and salary, not a part of A3120.1. It would seem, therefore, that Resolution #427z(3) suffers from a fatal, structural defect in that it amends a non-existing budget line, and further it does so by including a non-binding reference to a departmental Schedule 5. This veto was to eliminate that anomaly, but, beyond that point, this veto was necessary to keep the City from jeopardizing its Federal funding of this important police department function -- trained civilian dispatchers who allow trained police officers to be where they should be, doing police work.

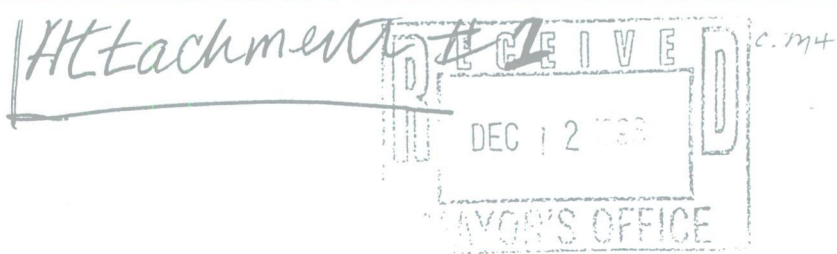

FAX MEMORANDUM

RE: Youth Center Budget

In 1996, the adopted Youth Center budget was \$50,000. This covered the cost of a Youth Center director and assistant, along with supplies, equipment, equipment repair, liability insurance, phone, postage, field trips, and scheduled off-site program activities. In May, I approached the Common Council and asked for additional funds to hire an additional part-time assistant. This was necessary to provide a "second set of eyes" at all times when the Youth Center was open. (When the handicapped lift was installed, the view from the upstairs program rooms to the gymnasium was completely blocked, and it was impossible for one person to safely supervise activities in the building. This was causing serious problems and was a liability concern.)

The requested 1997 Youth Center budget is for \$60,401. This accommodates the additional part-time assistant for the full twelve months of the year, and covers cost of living expenses. A decrease in \$15,000 to that budget would result in the following:

1. The additional assistant position would be eliminated. This would cause serious safety concerns, as sometimes youth would be in the building with only one adult chaperone, who would not be able to supervise all activities.
2. All field trips and off-site program activities would be eliminated. These are very popular and attract large numbers of youth.
3. There would be no equipment purchases, and the equipment that is there would not be able to be repaired. (The equipment receives heavy use and it is not uncommon for it to break.)
4. We would need to minimize consumable supplies such as soap, garbage bags, paper towels, toilet paper, and light bulbs.
5. The Youth Center is currently open 30 hours per week. We would have to look at a different schedule and most likely reduce the hours of operation. It should be noted that youth would like it open more hours per week, but present budgetary resources do not accommodate that.
