

**PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT  
COMMITTEE MEETING  
April 6, 2026**

Chairman Lautensack called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

***MEMBERS PRESENT:*** Councilor Lautensack, Councilor Thompson, and Councilor FitzGibbons.

***OTHERS PRESENT:*** Councilor Myer; Councilor Kennedy; Councilor Ashline; Councilor Plunkett; Mayor Robert Corradino; City Assessor, Kevin Hill; Interim City Engineer, John Trimble; Engineering Technician, Wesley Morse; Fire Chief, Paul Conzone.

***MEDIA PRESENT:*** No media present.

***OLD BUSINESS:*** There was no old business.

A motion to approve the minutes of the March 16, 2026, meeting was made by Councilor Thompson and seconded by Councilor FitzGibbons. Minutes were approved unanimously.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1. The Zoning and Planning Office requests that a public hearing be scheduled for the property known as Tax Map Nos. 127.75-01-01.02 & 127.75-01-15, for the proposed zone change from TN2, Traditional Neighborhood 2 to TB, Traditional Business Zoning District, pursuant to Section 280-96 of the Zoning Ordinance.**

Councilor FitzGibbons stated that he will remain recused. Councilor Thompson noted that the planning board meeting is scheduled for tomorrow to offer an advisory opinion and asked whether the committee should wait for a resolution before proceeding. Councilor Kennedy stated that he interpreted the item as a public hearing related to a zoning change and believed moving forward with the public hearing would likely be acceptable, while deferring the final decision to the committee.

**COMMITTEE DECISION:** Councilor Thompson made a motion to forward a favorable recommendation to the Full Council the request from the Zoning and Planning Office. Councilor Lautensack seconded the motion, it was approved by a vote of 2-0-0-1.

(Councilor FitzGibbons recused.)
