RESOLUTION OF NOVEMBER 17, 1997 AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A CAPITAL NOTE OF THE CITY OF OSWEGO IN THE PRINCIPAL SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$86,000.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE COST OF PHASE IV EAST SIDE SEWER SEPARATION & REHABILITATION TELEVISION INSPECTION PROGRAM.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OSWEGO AS FOLLOWS:

1. That a Capital Note of the City of Oswego in an amount not to exceed \$86,000.00 is hereby authorized to be issued for the purpose of financing the cost of Phase IV East Side Sewer Separation & Rehabilitation Television Inspection Program.
2. The maximum amount of the cost of the Oswego East Side Sewer Separation & Rehabilitation Television Inspection Program shall not exceed the sum of \$85,281.36 and (b) the cost of the contingencies shall not exceed the sum of \$718.64.
3. It is hereby determined that the purpose for which said note is to be issued in the cost of 2(a) above falls within subparagraph "62" of subdiviion "a" of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law, and that the period of probable usefulness of such purpose is no less than 3 years, and in the case of 2(b) above falls within subparagraph 40 of subdivision (a) of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law and that the period of probable usefulness is three (3) years.
4. Such Capital Note shall be signed by the Mayor of the City of Oswego and the City Chamberlain and the Corporate Seal of the City shall be affixed thereto and attested by the City Clerk.
5. The full faith and credit of the City of Oswego, New York are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of, and interest on, said note.
6. This Resolution shall take effect immediately and shall be published in full in the Oswego Palladium Times, the official newspaper.

Dear Mr. Nelson:

As you know, the Television Inspection Program did not include costs for moderate and heavy cleaning of the sewer lines. These unit prices are typically not included in the bid package because the TV contractors traditionally price these services high which greatly escalates the overall project cost using unit price bid.

The City has received a very reasonable price for the Phase IV TV Inspection Program. We have now asked Mr. Caputo, the low bidder, to supply us with the unit prices for the moderate and heavy cleaning (see attached correspondence). Based on his inspection of the City's Phase IV area and his experience, he estimates that approximately 25 percent of the sewer lines will require moderate cleaning and 10 percent will require heavy cleaning. This amounts to an increase of \$52,605.88 in the base bid to bring the total project costs to \$137,887.24. This price represents the estimated total cost to complete the entire TV Inspection of the Phase IV area. As you can see, it is also still lower than the second lowest bidder on the original bid documents.

We believe this price is reasonable and the City should authorize CDM to issue a change order to raise the upper limit to accommodate these expected costs. This information has been provided to you at this time so that the City Chamberlain and Council are aware of the potential increase in costs prior to approving the total expenditure of funds.

Pursuant to your request to formulate unit price structuring for "moderate" (4 to 8 passes), and "heavy" (9 passes or more) cleaning of sanitary sewers using a high velocity jetter, we present the following information based on 25% of total footage as moderate and 10% of total footage as heavy cleaning where applicable.

Please note that the unit prices we proposed in our Bid for light cleaning are a result of site survey, specific to this Phase IV contract. Further, the stated unit prices for moderate and heavy cleaning are also computed as a result of the estimated conditions of the Phase IV area and our pre-bid investigations.

We understand that your request for these unit prices is to establish a means of compensation to complete the work as required to prepare the sewers for an effective CCTV inspection program. We state for your consideration that the additional pay items are established to eliminate termination of cleaning at the completion of the 3rd pass, and wait for a written authorization to proceed with moderate or heavy cleaning, i.e. the cleaning will continue until properly completed and based on the number of passes will be classified light, moderate, or heavy and paid for as such.

Should the City of Oswego not accept this condition, there will be an additional charge to leave the line section and return after receipt of authorization. This additional charge will encompass re-mobilizing, equipment setup, manhole preparation, traffic control, and breakdown -demobilization.

We hope that this restructuring is acceptable to you and your client. Upon review, if you have any questions, please call. We have requested 4 copies of bonds and insurances to accompany the 4 original agreement forms to be dated 18Nov97, and will Federal Express or deliver to the City of Oswego by noon Monday, 17Nov97.
