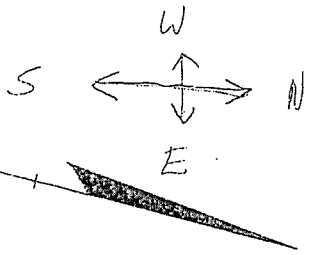

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,232,000 BONDS OF THE CITY OF OSWEGO, OSWEGO COUNTY, NEW YORK, TO PAY THE COST OF THE REHABILITATION OF THE HIGH DAM, IN AND FOR SAID CITY.

BY COUNCILOR Corradino

WHEREAS, all conditions precedent to the financing of the capital project hereinafter described, including compliance with the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQRA") as a Type II Action pursuant to the regulations thereunder, have been performed and it has been determined that, as such, the capital project will not have any significant adverse environmental impact; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to authorize the financing of such capital project; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, by the affirmative vote of **not less than two-thirds of the total voting strength** of the Common Council of the City of Oswego, Oswego County, New York, as follows:

Section 1. For the specific object or purpose of paying the cost of the rehabilitation of the concrete spillway and supporting structures at the High Dam, in and for the City of Oswego, Oswego County, New York, including incidental improvements, appurtenances and expenses in connection therewith, there are hereby authorized to be issued \$1,232,000 bonds of said City pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 2. It is hereby determined that the maximum estimated of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is \$1,232,000, which specific object or purpose is authorized at said maximum estimated cost, and the plan for the financing thereof is by the issuance of the \$1,232,000 bonds of said City authorized to be issued pursuant to this bond resolution.

Section 3. It is hereby further determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is thirty years, pursuant to subdivision 22 of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law.

Section 4. The faith and credit of said City of Oswego, Oswego County, New York, are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. There shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said City, a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same become due and payable.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the serial bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the City Chamberlain, the chief fiscal officer of said City. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as October be prescribed by said City Chamberlain, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 6. Such bonds shall be in fully registered form and shall be signed in the name of the City of Oswego, Oswego County, New York, by the manual or facsimile signature of the City Chamberlain and a facsimile of its corporate seal shall be imprinted or impressed thereon and October be attested by the manual or facsimile signature of the City Clerk.

Section 7. All other matters, except as provided herein relating to such bonds herein authorized including date, denominations, maturities, interest payment dates, and whether said bonds shall be repaid in accordance with a schedule providing for substantially level or declining annual debt service, within the limitations prescribed herein and the manner of execution of the same and also including the consolidation with other issues, shall be determined by the City Chamberlain, the chief fiscal officer of such City. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals in addition to those required by section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the City Chamberlain shall determine consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 8. This resolution shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150-2. Other than as specified in this resolution, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

Section 9. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes October be contested only if:

- 1) Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said City is not authorized to expend money, or

2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this Bond Resolution are not substantially complied with, and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 10. The City Clerk shall cause this resolution to be published in summary form in the *Oswego Palladium-Times*, the official newspaper of said City, together with a notice in substantial conformity with Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law, and such resolution shall take effect immediately upon such publication.

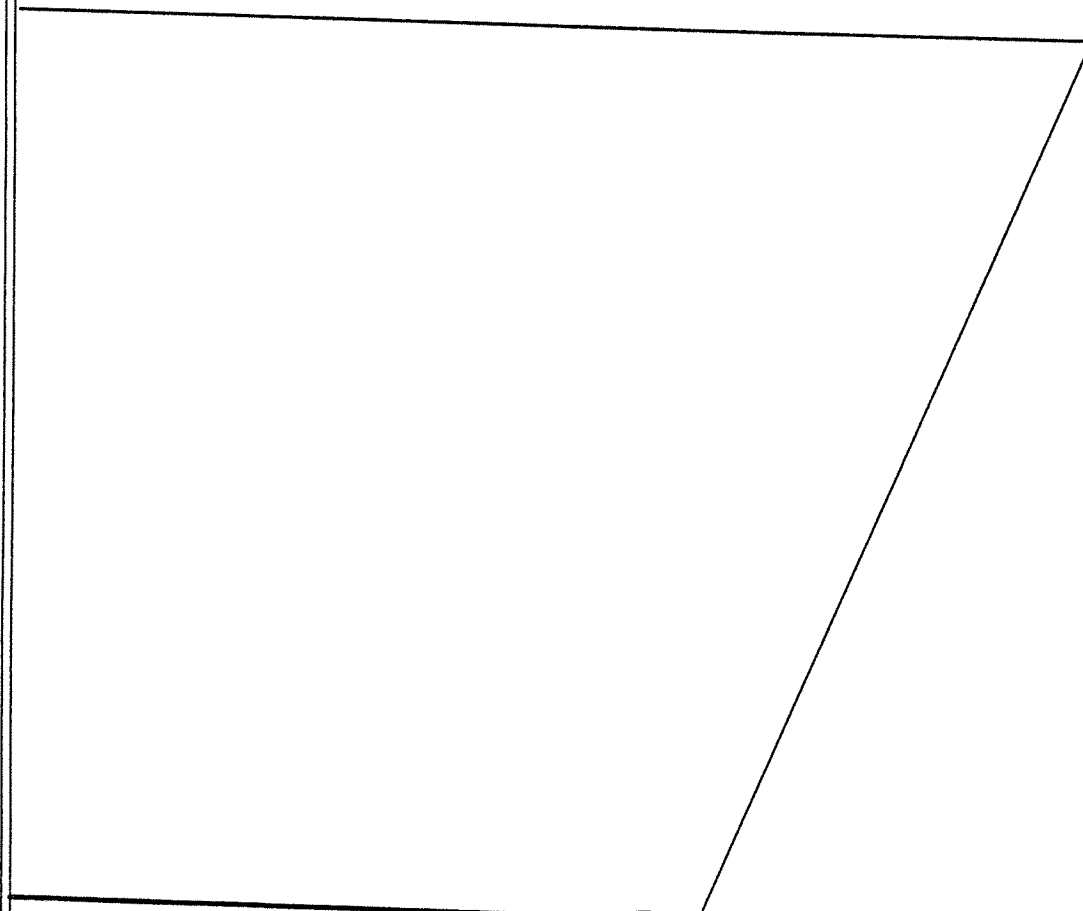
